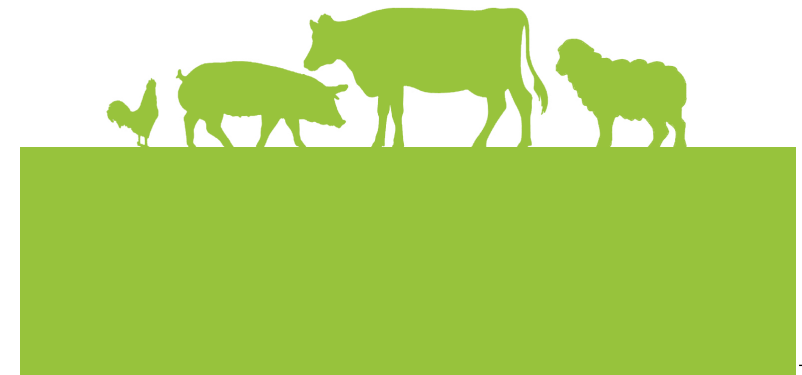

Programmes of the meetings are drawn up from the input by the members involved in the day to day issues of the industry. Speakers, renowned for their expertise and clarity, are chosen from industry, research establishments and universities in the UK or overseas.

### These meetings:

- are species specific.
- maintain personal contacts between field technologists.
- provide a forum where individuals can meet to discuss issues and problems related to the industry.
- provide up-to-date developments in feed technology.
- enable individuals to liaise with the expert scientists and technologists in their fields.
- form a valuable part of training to enable technologists to stay abreast of all the developments.
- are approved by the Society of Biology for purposes of CPD.

**Annual Proceedings** – The papers presented at the conferences held by the Society are reproduced at the end of each year and distributed to all members, free of charge.

**Study Tours** – Trips to locations in the UK and abroad are organised by the Society to look at areas that would be of interest to the members.

**The Edgar Pye Research Scholarship** – Following the untimely death of Edgar J Pye in July, 1989, whilst he held the office of President of the Society of Feed Technologists, the Society decided to set up the Edgar Pye Research Scholarship Trust (Registration Charity No: 1004754) to perpetuate Edgar's memory by the presentation of a Research Scholarship on a regular basis. The aim is to sponsor an annual research project. Entries are judged by a panel of judges selected by the Trustees of the Research Scholarship Trust and the final paper is presented by the winner at a SFT conference.
